Scholarship Award

This award is to assist the applicant in furthering his/her education in a 2 or 4 year accredited college or university. Exact dollar amount of each scholarship will depend on investment returns and number of qualified applicants.

Eligibility

Those eligible to apply are:

1. The children of members of Mount Hermon Lodge No. 263, who are in good standing.
2. The grandchildren of members of Mount Hermon Lodge No. 263, who are in good standing.
3. The children/grandchildren of deceased members of Mount Hermon Lodge No. 263, who were in good standing at the time of their death.

Applicant's Responsibility

Applicant shall submit on or before April 1st unless otherwise noted the following:

1. Completed application
2. Current certified transcript of scholastic records
3. Photocopy of ACT and/or SAT test scores if available
4. Three or more letters of recommendation submitted on or before April 15th, with at least one from applicants school principal or counselor, and one from a responsible member of the community (a business / professional person, teacher, civic or organizational leader), and one from a member of the clergy. Letters should address the following information:
 - A. Attest to standards of conduct, strength of character, adherence to truth and conscience, devotion to academics, church and community.
 - B. Describe involvement in activities of church, school, volunteerism, community involvement and other organizations.
 - C. Applicants ability to complete planned course of study.
 - D. Basis of financial need if known.
5. Additional pages of narrative or supporting documentation may be added. This can include newspaper clippings, photographs, letters and other materials, which will give the committee a better insight about you.

Re-application

A student who has previously received a Mt Hermon scholarship may reapply. Applicant who is reapplying will submit to the Mt. Hermon Lodge No. 263 Scholarship chairman a current certified transcript of applicants scholastic record showing reasonable progress, and a letter from the students advisor indicating the student's progress, attitude and general ability.

The Mt. Hermon Lodge No. 263 Scholarship committee will award the scholarships.

Completed applications must be postmarked by April 1st to the attention of the Scholarship Committee.
